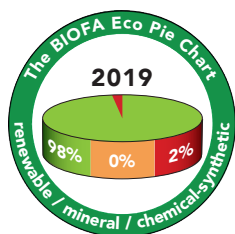
Properties:

BIOFA Terrace Cleaner is a highly effective concentrate for fast and thorough, but gentle cleaning. Removes green coatings and other soiling from patio surfaces, screens, garden furniture, pergolas, etc. made of untreated or oiled wood outdoors. Also suitable for surfaces made of plastic and composite materials (check compatibility) as well as stone, concrete, exposed aggregate concrete, eternit, roof tiles, walkway slabs and similar. It is low odor, formaldehyde and phosphate free.

For refreshing/treatment of already grayed surfaces we recommend the use of BIOFA Entgrauer 2089!

Ingredients:

Wasser, < 5% amphotere Tenside.

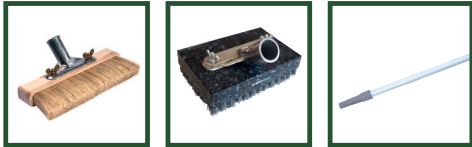


Directions for Use:

- 1. Pretreatment:** brush off coarse impurities, if necessary clean the surfaces with a high-pressure cleaner first.
- 2. Processing:** Depending on the degree of soiling, dilute the concentrate with 1-3 parts water and apply evenly and saturated (but without puddling) to the dry substrate with a brush, watering can or garden sprayer. Extreme soiling, discoloration and heavy green infestation can be treated with undiluted concentrate. Then spread with a brush, work well into grooves, crevices and corrugations and allow to react for at least 15-30 minutes. Then rinse well with clear water. In stubborn cases, repeat the process.
Important: Before re-treatment with oil, the surfaces must be completely dry.
- 3. Post treatment and care:** After-treatment and care of the wooden decking with BIOFA Decking Oil Art. No. 3753 gives the wood fresh color and protection again. Garden furniture is treated with BIOFA Teak Oil Art. No. 3752 after-treated.
- 4. Equipment cleaning:** Clean immediately after use with clear water.



Recommended Equipment:



- 1. 009942** Flat brush 240 mm
- 2. 009902** Terrace brush 150 x 100 mm
- 3. 009973** Tool handle

Consumption/yield per coat:

Approx. 100-130 ml/m² (equivalent to 7-10m²/l) are applied per coat. Consumption and yield, however, strongly depend on the application method and the absorbency and condition of the substrate.
1 l of pure Terrace Cleaner is sufficient for approx. 7-10 m².
1 l Terrace Cleaner diluted 1:3 (results in 4 l) is sufficient for approx. 28-40 m².

Storage:

Keep cool, dry, protect from frost, and store properly sealed.

Disposal:

Use up product completely if possible. Wash out soaked working materials well. Liquid product residues and containers which are not completely empty and cleaned must be disposed of in accordance with local/national regulations.
